## Minor Minutes

Praise God for his mercies and traveling grace. Pastor Sandi is back home and none the worse for the journey. If you were one of those who missed the news, she went on a United Methodist Volunteers in Mission trip with Kenya Partners, INC. They are a non-profit group with a mission to mobilize individuals and churches to work together to make a difference in the lives of our Kenyan sisters and brothers.

As their website notes in its introduction:

In a country ravaged by poverty, conflict and HIV/AIDS, a country where most people can barely find enough to eat, a country where medicine is a luxury and where mothers frequently die in childbirth and where children die of malaria and ordinary childhood diseases, a young Kenyan pharmacist was called to the ministry. Giving up a career which offered security and comforts for his family, Pastor Josam Kariuki started a church under a tree in 2003. When three people from a North Carolina church visited Nakuru, Kenya, in 2006, after learning about this extraordinary "practical" ministry on the Nakuru website, they discovered that this young minister had a vision to minister to the physical and economic needs of the people in this community, as well as their spiritual needs.

Since this first meeting with Pastor Josam, teams have traveled to Nakuru to offer medical and dental services, a children's ministry program, and to assist in the construction of a boarding school for the street children and orphans. The focus of these missions is to create authentic relationships with the local people being served, while providing resources to equip and empower them to break the cycle of extreme poverty and bring about positive change in their lives. Such work strikes at the heart of one of the foci of our denominational ministry initiatives, combating the causes of world poverty and disease.

Pastor Sandi can attest, it makes a profound difference to personally see such poverty and disease close up. She has returned with hundreds of stories to tell. We may try to get her to come and share some of them with us. One story she tells is particularly poignant to me. She tells of an excursion the team was going on soon after they had encountered a particularly heavy rain storm. When they got to the river they found it swollen over its banks. A vehicle had attempted to cross and had misjudged the path and become stuck in the middle of the river. The road was beginning to back up with other vehicles which could not cross because the stuck vehicle was blocking the way for all other traffic. I am reminded of 1 Corinthians 8:9

But take heed lest by any means this liberty of yours become a **stumbling** block to them that are weak.

This one driver had taken the liberty that was his to venture across the swollen river, but in doing so and being ill prepared for such a crossing had created a problem for many others.

There is the tendency on our part to believe our actions are our own and no concern of others. The truth is quite different. We are connected. Our actions are not simply our own, but have an effect on others even many we do not know. Romans 15:1-2, from the Message, put it this way:

Those of us who are strong and able in the faith need to step in and lend a hand to those who falter, and not just do what is most convenient for us. Strength is for service, not status. Each one of us needs to look after the good of the people around us, asking ourselves, "How can I help?"

In all that we do we must do it not only with our thoughts on ourselves but also on how our actions might help or hurt others. In so living we become a living witness to the glory of God.

# MUSIC MINISTRY By Kaleb Rangel

Un día Bach le dijo a un estudiante: Sólo practique diligentemente y todo irá bien. Usted tiene cinco dedos en su mano tan saludables como los míos”. Cuando éste le preguntó cuál fue el secreto de su éxito? él respondió: “ Yo fui hecho para trabajar, si tú eres igualmente productivo, serás igualmente exitoso”. Juan Sebastián Bach fue devoto a Dios y un día dijo: “Donde hay música devocional, Dios está al alcance de la mano con su graciosa presencia”. Los músicos no son producto de casualidades, sino de devoción, entrega y diligencia. No importa tu profesión u oficio...no es asunto de casualidades sino de devoción, entrega y diligencia.

Johann Sebastian was orphaned at the age of nine years and so was raised by his brother, starting his musical training there. Bach one day said: "The only purpose of music should be for the Glory of God and recreation of the human spirit." One day, Bach told a student: Just practice diligently and everything will be fine. You have five healthy fingers on your hand as I do. "When he asked him what was the secret of his success? he replied: "I was made to work, if you are equally productive, you will be equally successful." Johann Sebastian Bach was devoted to God and one day said: "Where there is devotional music, God is available with his gracious presence." The musicians are not a product of casualty but of devotion, dedication and diligence. No matter what your profession is... it is not a matter of casualty but of devotion, dedication and diligence.
